Free screenings for breast and cervical cancer at The Bethesda Life Center

The Bethesda Life Center, Inc. is now a provider for the Alabama Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program (ABCCEDP).

The Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program provides qualified women with breast and cervical cancer screening at no cost. Women who are screened and diagnosed with breast and/or cervical cancer may be eligible for treatment through Medicaid.

If you are a resident of Alabama, aged 40 to 64, uninsured or underinsured, and have an income at or below 200% of the federal poverty level, you qualify. Women who are 65 and older enrolled in Medicare Part A only are also eligible. All eligible women may receive a pelvic exam, pap smear, clinical breast exam, and mammogram at not cost.
