BIBLE LESSON:

Psalms 91 – God's Umbrella of Protection (Angels)

Memory Verse:

"For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways; they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone." Psalms 91: 11-12 NIV

BOTTOM LINE:

God's angels are always with me.



PRAISE AND WORSHIP

You are never too young to praise and worship God! Time to sing and dance!

Click J-E-S-U-S for today's song.

FAITH TIME

Before we get started, let's talk about FAITH! Why? Because faith pleases God (Hebrews 11:6)! Since we can't see God's angels protecting us, we must use our faith to put our angels to work!

My EARS hear GOD'S WORD. (Point to your ears)

My **HEART** believes GOD'S WORD. (*Point to your heart*)

My MOUTH confesses GOD'S WORD. (Point to your mouth)

My HANDS go to work. (Wave your hands in the air)


SNACK TIME

Did you know that angels are real even though you don't see them?

God created the angels to watch over you and protect you.

Remember to thank God every day for the angels that He sends to protect you from harm.





LET'S TALK

(Ask these questions after going over the Bible Lesson)

Who created angels? God

Why did God create angels? To watch over you and protect you

What should we do every day? Thank God for the angels

PRAYER

(have child repeat after you; if they are too small to talk, then pray the prayer for them and replace "me" with your child/children's name)

God, thank you for sending your angels to watch over me and protect me every day. In Jesus name, Amen!

AT-HOME ACTIVITIES

- What you need: Paper, markers or crayons
 - What you do: Help your child draw an outline of an angel and write things on the inside of the angel that God's angels protect them from.
- What you need: Spoon or lollipop, tissue or paper towel, string or rubber band
 - What you do: Take the tissue or paper towel and place it over the spoon, then take the string or rubber band to put around the "neck" of the angel. You can even draw a happy face on the angel.
 Allow your child to fly their angel around as they thank God for His protection.
