## WHAT YOU NEED:

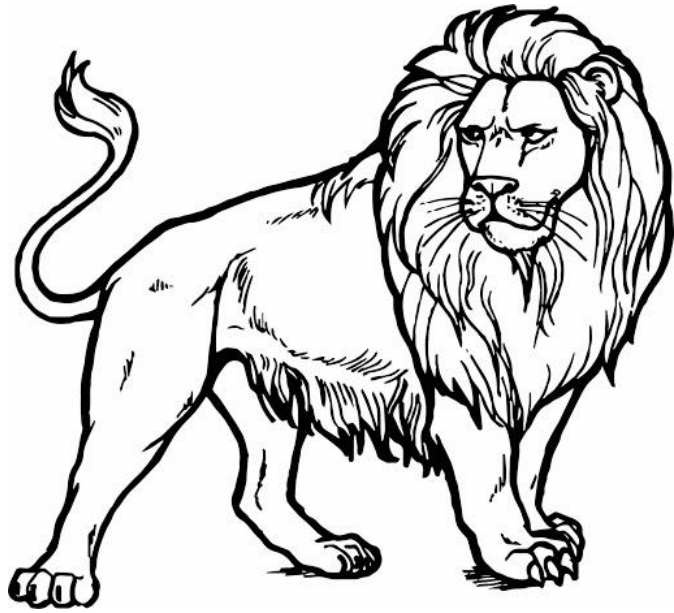
- “No Fear” activity page *(or make your own)*

## What You Do:

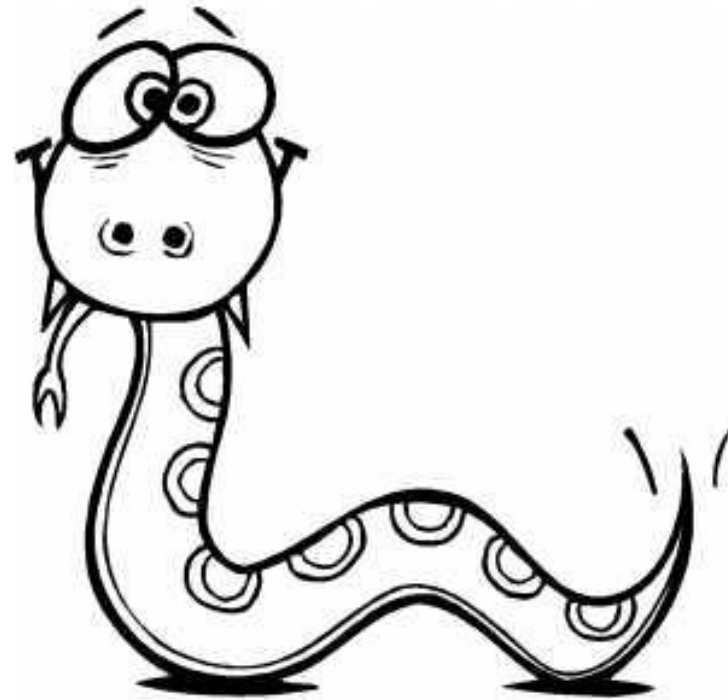
- Color the animals on the page and talk about how the devil might try to scare you.

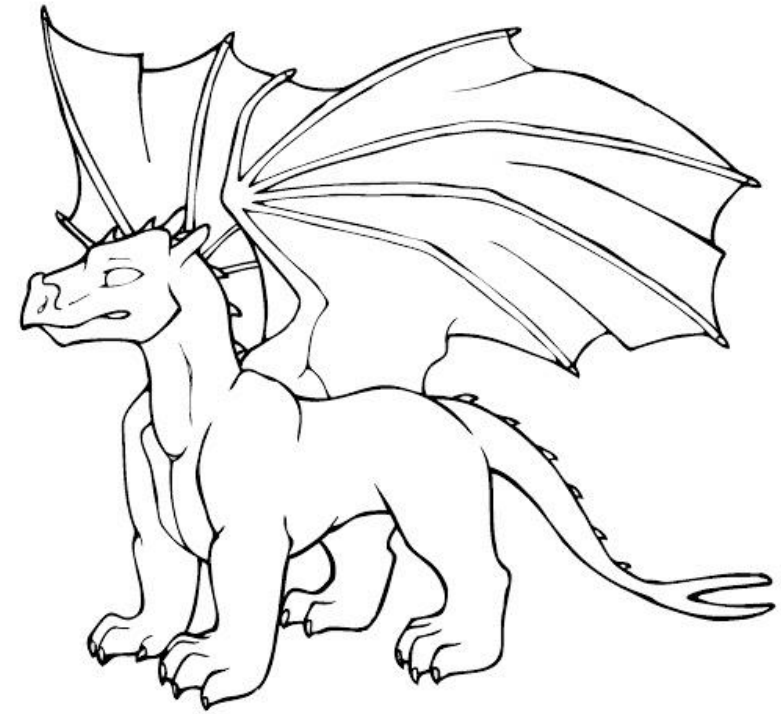
Color the animals. Then use the scripture verse strips to place over each animal and say the scripture **OUT LOUD** each time.

Ugly snake



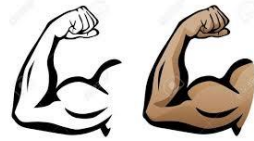

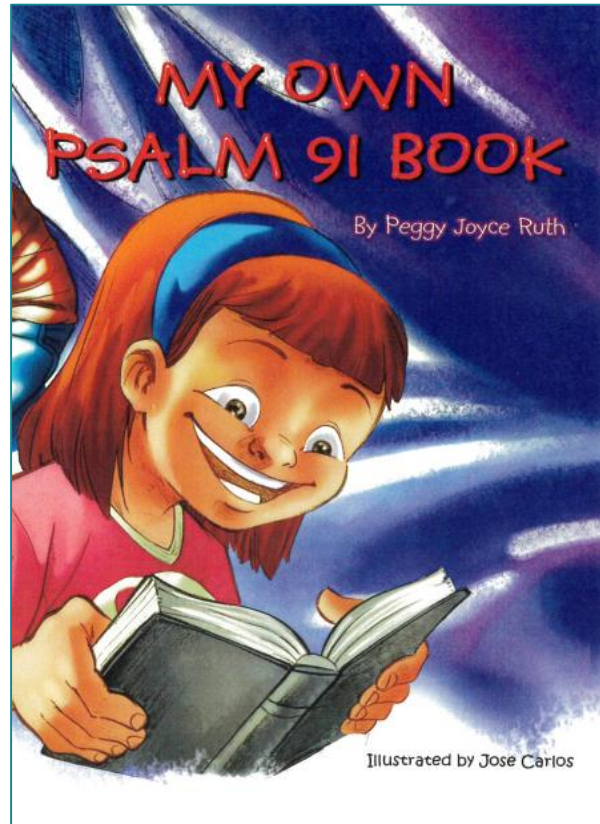

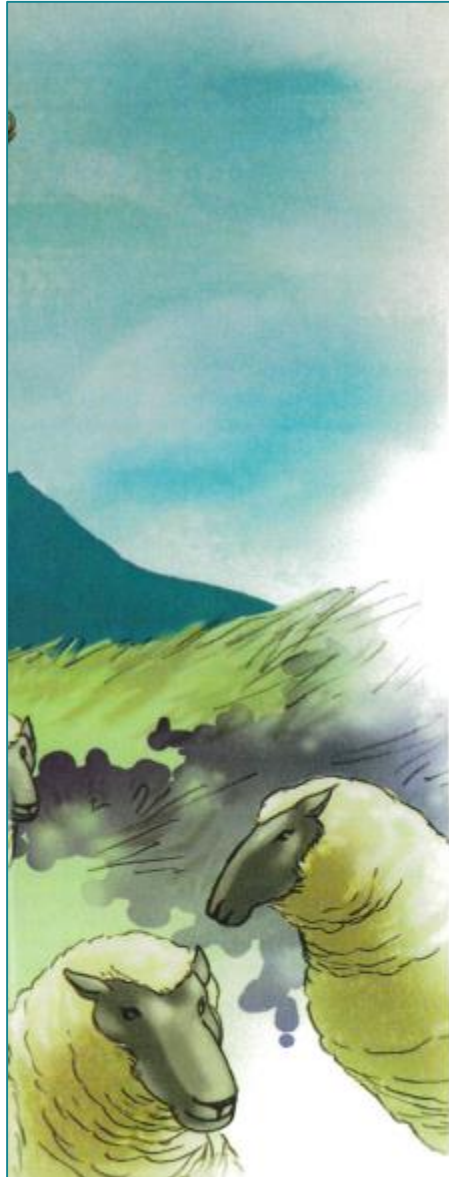


## Verse 1

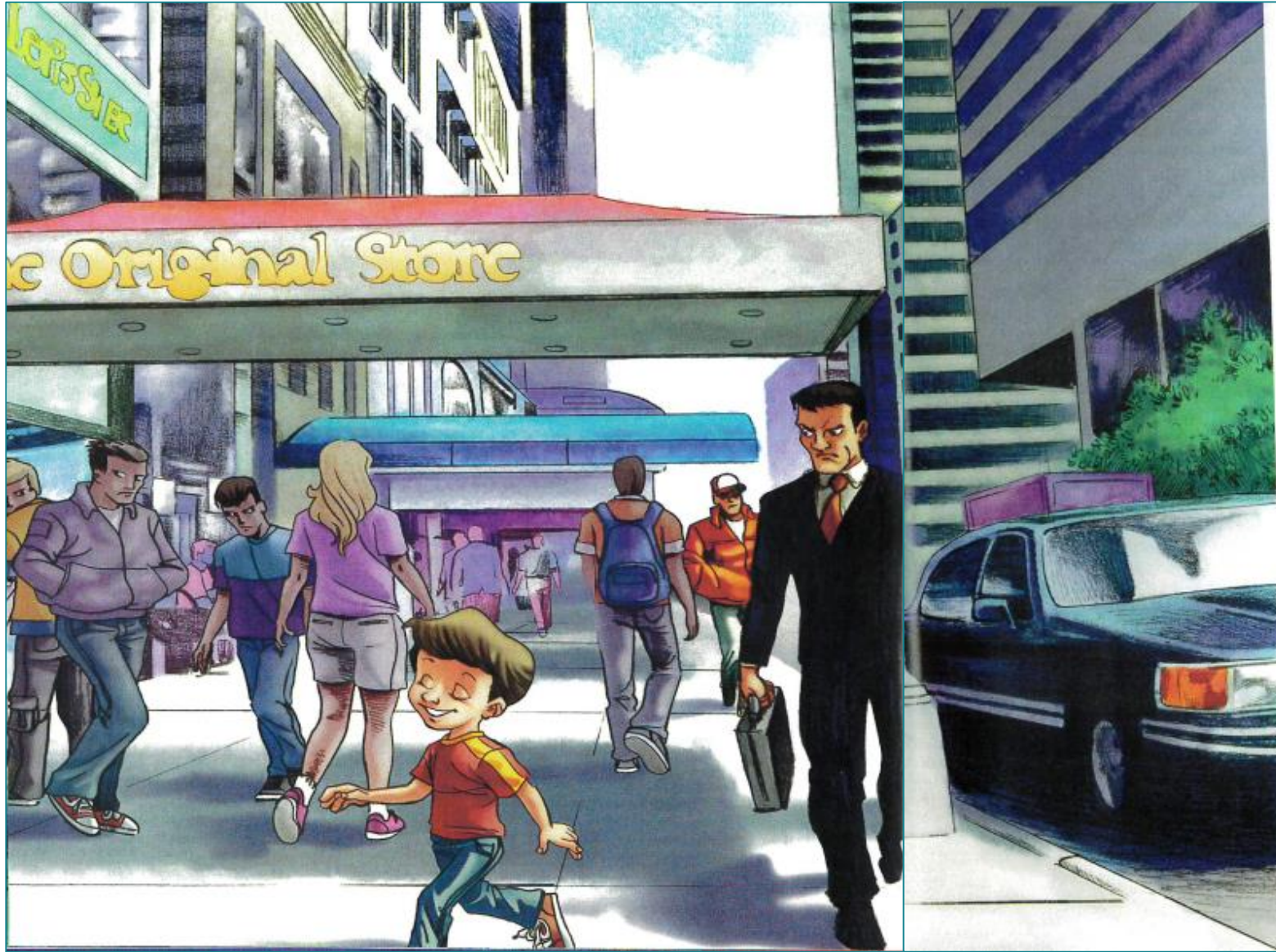

## Verses 6b-10

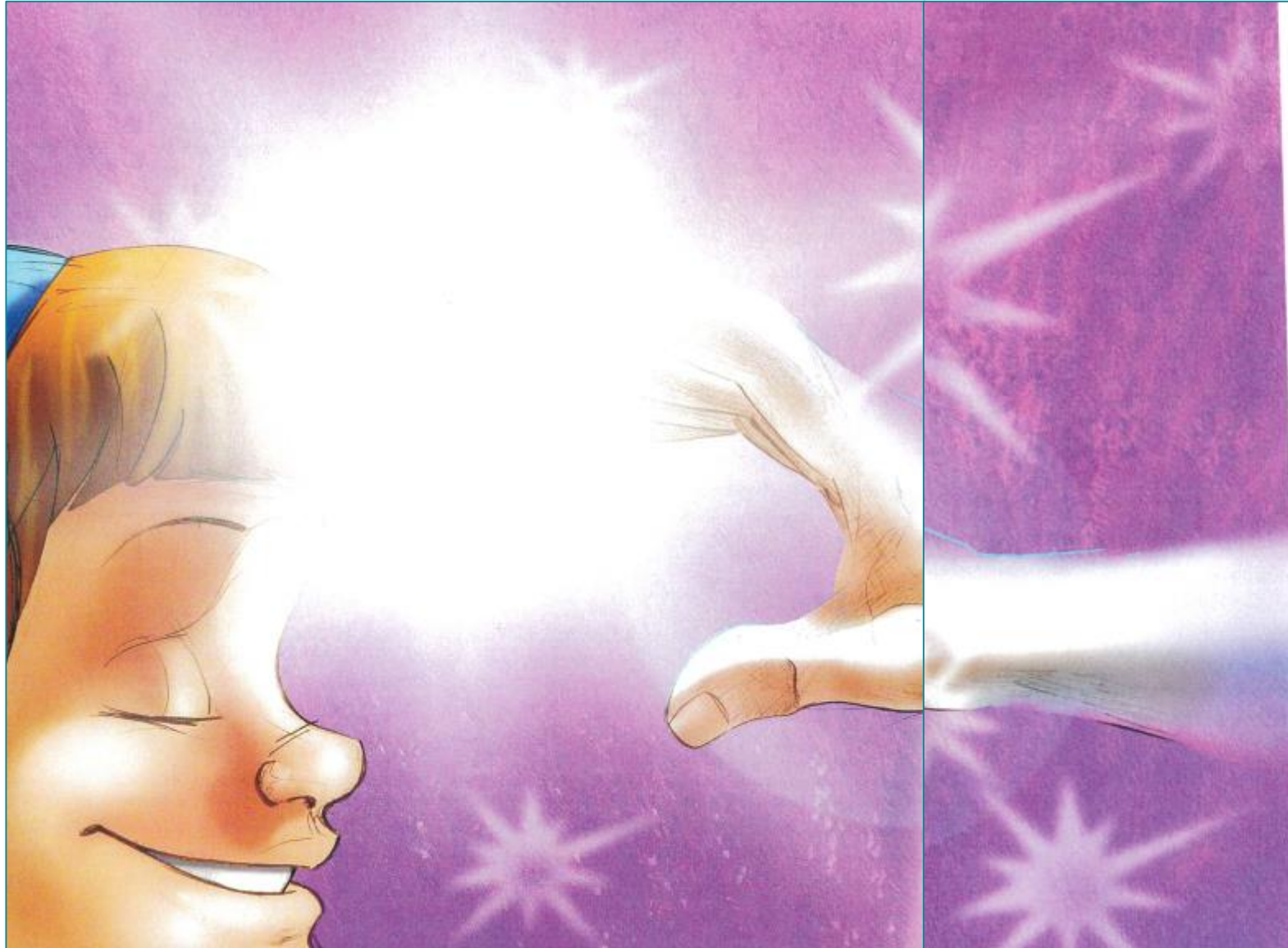

# Our Psalms 91 Confession

*Lord, I thank you that:*

1. I stay in the safety of You God and stay close to Your shadow.
2. You are my hiding place, my God, in You I trust.
3. For You delivered me from the devil's traps, and from the deadly disease.
4. You cover me with Your power, and under Your care I find safety. Your faithfulness is a shield and a wall of safety around me.
5. I do not fear of the terror that comes at night, or the bad things the devil tries to put in my mind.
6. Nor the disease that tries to come in at night, not even the destruction that comes at noonday.
7. A thousand can fall at one side and ten thousand can fall at my other side, but destruction will not come near me.
  
9. Because I have made You, Lord my dwelling place, and the Most High God, my refuge (and place of safety).
10. No evil shall be allowed to take me down, and no plague will come near my body.
11. For You command Your angels to guard me in all I do.
12. In their hands they hold me up; I will not even strike my foot on a rock.
13. Evil things may come, but I will trample them under my feet.
14. Why? Because I stay close to You, God, I know You love me and protect me, because I know You personally.
15. When I call You God, you answer me and help me when I'm in trouble.
16. You satisfy me with long life and Your salvation.
